This is an application to the Secretary of the Department of Health and Aged Care made under section 10N of the Narcotic Drugs Act to vary a medicinal cannabis licence granted under that Act.

Implementation of variations

Variations sought through this application must not be implemented by the licence holder until a decision approving the application, when made by the delegate, is notified in writing by the ODC. It should be noted that the lodgment of an application to vary a licence does not constitute approval to commence or continue activities that would be unauthorised under an existing licence. Conducting authorised activities where

facilities or security arrangements have not been approved may be a breach of the licence and unlawful.

Privacy

The ODC collects a variety of personal information in the course of performing its functions. Personal information is defined in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) (Privacy Act). Your personal information is protected by law under the Privacy Act, which contains the Australian Privacy Principles. The ODC is part of the Australian Government Department of Health and Aged Care.
